Domestic

Successful completion of NCEA Level 2, including: 12 credits in Mathematics(excluding statistics), a minimum of 12 literacy credits at NCEA Level 1, or above.

International

Successful completion of one year of tertiary study in the fields of either architecture, business, construction or quantity surveying and/or one year work experience within the industry is preferred or high school diploma + online interview.

ENGLISH REQUIREMENTS

PTE **TOEFL IBT**

Overall band of 6.0 with no individual band less than 5.5. 50 overall score - with no band score lower than 42. Overall score of 60 (with at least 18 in Writing).
